.....Traditional party games, tea and a visit from Father Christmas. All the children that come to nursery are welcome .Please let us know ASAP if your child will be coming

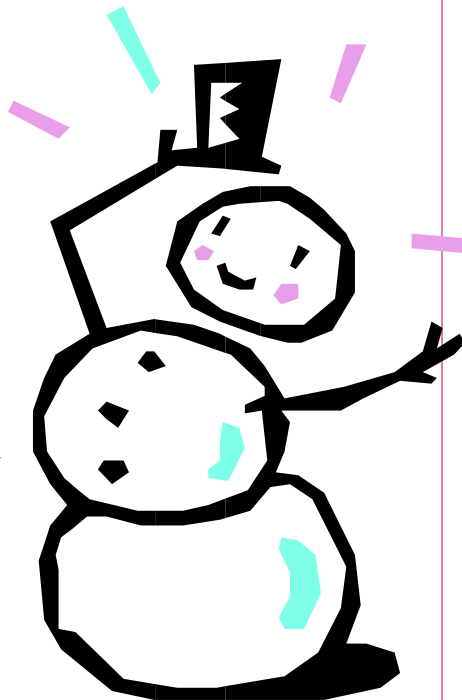
Winter is here,

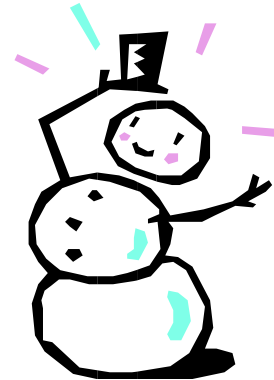
Thank you so much for all the donations of recycling modeling material. The children really enjoy using the materials and engaging their imagination.
